## JUNE WORKING MORNINGS FRIDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> SATURDAY 9<sup>TH</sup>

Here is a list of general maintenance jobs that need doing this month as advised by the church architect on her recent visit.

1. Clear all the dead leaves away from around both the church and the Hall especially outside the Hall Kitchen and in front of the Hall and in the trench around the crypt. Ensure the leaves have been taken out of the drain covers.
2. Prune the roses on the south side of the church remove all the weeds growing in the flower beds on the south side. This includes brambles which are clogging drains. Check the soil levels which appear to be high.
3. Remove all weeds growing at the foot of the building in the trench running around the crypt.
4. Remove all the weeds and saplings growing in the drainage areas running the length of the west and south side of the hall. These should be kept clear at all times.
5. Trim the fuschia bushes growing on the west side of the church, remove all the weeds growing between them. Begin clearing the garden area outside the entrance to the church and running alongside the footpath to keep the footpath running around the church clear and wide enough to be safely used by all.

The above list are jobs which must be done for the good of the buildings and the safety of people using the footpaths. There are more tasks to do relating to the general maintenance of the church grounds.

Please come along and lend a hand if you possibly can. It is our church we should all have an interest in maintaining the buildings and the grounds.
