Take the B6051 from Owlbar to Chesterfield via Cordwell Valley. Continue on this road following signs to Town Centre. Straight on at traffic lights. Look for the co-op on your left at a mini roundabout. Immediately after there is the Nag's Head on your right and Tandoori Indian Restaurant on your left. Turn right into Hastings Close. The observatory is at the top right. Journey time about 20 mins
