The PCC needs a secretary!

A secretary takes minutes at the meeting, distributes them to PCC members and circulates reports and agendas before meetings. (These are prepared by PCC members, not the secretary) The secretary also receives correspondence for the church and the PCC. The secretary doesn't need to be a member of the PCC but needs to be at the meetings. There are 6 meetings a year, held on the 2nd Monday of the month.

Maintenance of the church and grounds.
