Ground Keeping

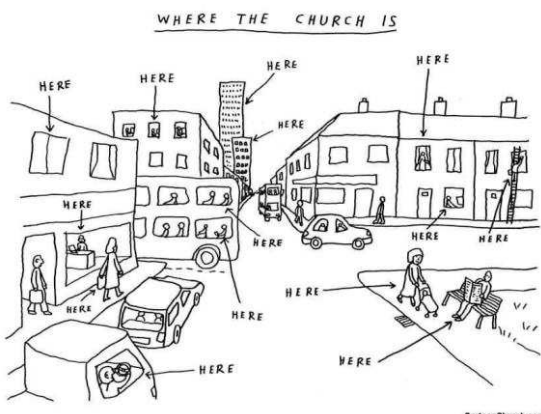
